Course Descriptions for Special Topics courses

ACC 491 Readings & Research in Accounting

Forensic Fraud

This course is a survey of various financial criminal activities ranging from identity theft, embezzlement, tax fraud, credit card fraud, and other emerging areas of financial fraud. Students will work individually and in teams to research and present written and oral case studies that will identify fraud and legal enforcement issues. The course is open to accounting, business, criminal justice and other majors.

Prerequisite: senior standing.

CPS 480 Computer Security

Special Topics in Computer Science

This course introduces a wide range of information security concepts, fundamentals and basic techniques. It is intended to form the foundation for further inquiry into the SANS Security Essentials and CISSP 10 domains. You will learn the language and underlying theories of information security as well as current tools and methods including the strengths and weaknesses of each. The text is designed to prepare students for the core SANS programs- GIAC Security Essentials Certification. Prerequisites: CPS100 Introduction to Computers and BUS280 Business Information Processing.
