## Tuition & Fees English Language Institute (ELI)

2011-2012 Academic Year (September to May)

Fall term 2011 starts on Monday, August 29, 2011

Spring term 2012 starts on Wednesday, January 11, 2012

**ELI Tuition and Fees** \$9,110/academic year (\$4,550/term, summer not included)

**Note:** An F-1 visa international student must study full-time each term (fall and spring) to maintain his/her visa status. Summer term is optional, and you are not required to take any classes if you don't want to)

**Room & Meals (on campus)** \$6,590 academic year  
(double occupancy room in halls with 100 meals/term)

(Meal plans: you may select 100, 150 or 200 meals per term. Plans with more meals cost more.)

**Books** \$800 (estimated/year)

**Health Insurance** \$1,150 (estimated/year)

**Miscellaneous Personal Expenses** \$1,000 (estimated)

**Summer Living Expenses** \$1,600 (estimated from June to August)

**Orientation Fee** \$100 (one time fee for **new** international students only)

**Total for a SEVIS I-20** **\$20,350.00 (estimated for 12 months)**

The above figures are meant to serve as guidelines and are subject to change. In order to be accepted and obtain a student visa (F-1), you must prove that you will be supported fully for your entire course of study without recourse to employment.

**An institutional TOEFL test** is given at Lakeland College a few days before each term begins. If you achieve the required score on the test, you may go directly into academic classes without studying in the ELI. At the end of each semester, your English proficiency will be evaluated using the test, a writing sample, an interview, and other measures. When you successfully pass this combination of criteria, you may enter an academic program at Lakeland. If you do well but are not yet ready to enter an academic program full time, you may take some academic classes and some ELI classes.

**All international applications are processed on a rolling basis, and there is no deadline.** Your application for admission and supporting credentials should be submitted as early as possible to allow sufficient time to process your application, obtain your visa, and arrange for transportation.
