The Daily Grind The Daily Grind is an on-campus espresso bar including breakfast items.

Muskie Mart/Grill The Muskie Mart and Grill is a convenience store along with a short-order grill.

The Pub The Pub is a casual gathering spot with free popcorn along with pizza, pretzels and nachos for purchase.
