

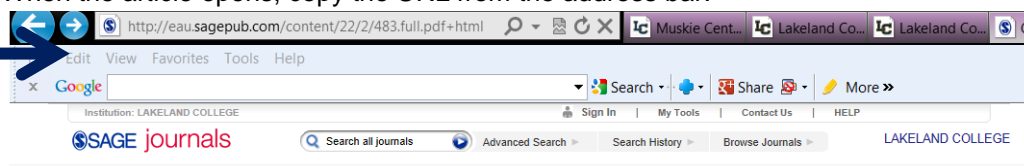
Linking to Sage Content

1. Once you locate an article in SAGE, click on *Full Text (PDF)*.

Search Results



2. When the article opens, copy the URL from the address bar.



3. You will need to take the URL that you just copied and modify it to include information about Lakeland's system for password authentication (EZproxy system). To create a URL for linking, follow this formula:

EZprozy URL (remains the same) + article URL (changes with each article) = linking URL.

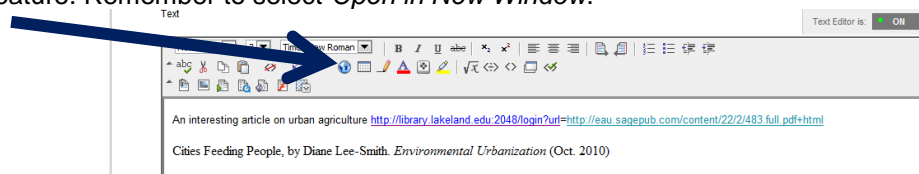
EZproxy URL is always <http://library.lakeland.edu:2048/login?url=>

For the article, *Cities feeding people*, the url is <http://eau.sagepub.com/content/22/2/483.full.pdf+html>

The link that will be pasted into Blackboard is

4. Go to Blackboard. Access your course. Under *Build Content*, select *Web Link* and paste the newly created URL. Under options, be sure to check *Open in New Window*.
5. Although adding a link as described in #4 is the recommended method, links can be added into text by using the hyperlink feature. Remember to select *Open in New Window*.
