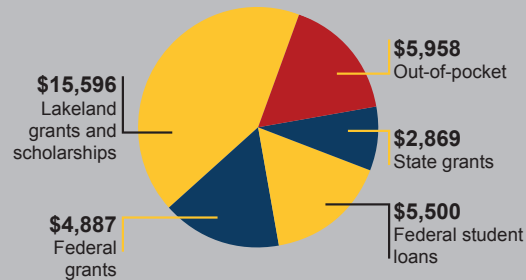

THAT'S WHY LAKELAND IS CHANGING IT IN BIG AND AFFORDABLE WAYS.

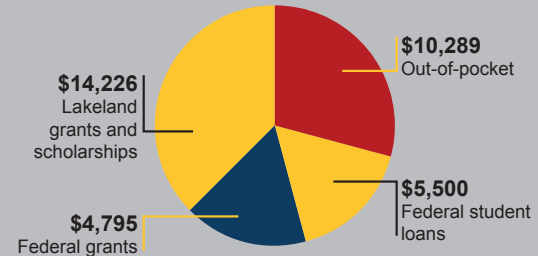
