Fall term starts on Monday, August 26, 2013 Spring term starts on Wednesday, January 8, 2014



Figures are meant to serve as guidelines and are subject to change, In order to obtain an F-1 student visa, you must prove that you will be supported fully for your entire course of study without recourse to employment.

**Tuition & Fees** \$11,475 per academic year [\$5,165 per academic term]

An F-1 visa international student must study full-time each term [fall and spring]

to maintain his/her visa status. Summer term is optional.

**Orientation Fee** \$100 [one time fee for a new international students only]

**Room & Meals [on campus]** \$7,700 per academic year [double occupancy room in halls with 150 meals per term]

You may select 100, 150 or 200 meals per term. Plans with more meals cost more.

**Books** \$950 [estimated]

**Health Insurance** \$1,200 [estimated for 12 months]

Miscellaneous Personal Expenses \$2,800 [estimated]

**Summer Living Expenses** \$1,700 [estimated from June to August]

Total for a SEVIS I-20 \$25,925 [estimated for 12 months]

An institutional TOEFL test is given at Lakeland College a few days before each term begins. If you achieve the required score on the test, you may go directly into academic classes without studying in the ELI. At the end of each semester, your English proficiency will be evaluated using the test, a writing sample, an interview, and other measures. When you successfully pass this combination of criteria, you may enter an academic program at Lakeland. If you do well but are not yet ready to enter an academic program full time, you may take some academic classes and some ELI classes.

All international applications are processed on a rolling basis and there is no deadline. Your application for admission and supporting credentials should be submitted as early as possible to allow sufficient time to process your application, obtain your visa and arrange for transportation.
